

PRIVACY INFORMATION

This information note is provided in compliance with Regulation (EC) 45/2001 to those who interact with the services of the IPA Adriatic CBC Programme which may be accessed online from the address <http://www.adriaticpacbc.org> and not for other external services /sites not covered by this private information.

Abruzzo Region, as Authority responsible for managing personal data, ensures that the processing of personal data stored during the management of the Programme is in compliance with what envisaged by privacy regulation in force.

Purpose of data processing

Abruzzo Region processes personal data only if strictly necessary for the fulfilment of the institutional functions; specific purposes, concerning the single processing will be reported in details within the several access channels. Within them the User will find additional information on personal data processing. Abruzzo Region's services, responsible for the Programme management, will not communicate or disclose any data. It will use them exclusively for communication concerning the website and its contents.

Methods of data processing

Personal data are processed by means of both manual and automated tools as long as strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they have been stored.

Place of data processing

The processing linked to the services of Abruzzo Region in charge of the Programme management are located at Abruzzo Region's office and are handled only by the staff of the Department responsible for the processing, or by possible persons providing technical assistance to the Programme.

Personal data provided by the Users within the Programme management are used only for service request purposes.

Owner of the processing

The owner of the processing is the public body Abruzzo Region "Direzione Affari della Presidenza, Politiche Legislative e Comunitarie, Programmazione, Parchi, Territorio, Valutazioni ambientali, Energia – Servizio Attività Internazionali" based in L'Aquila, Via Salaria Antica est n. 27

Rights of data subjects

Data subjects to whom the personal data refer are whenever entitled to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of the same data and to know its content and origin, check its accuracy, or ask for its integration or updating, or rectification. Users have also the right to ask for the deletion, anonymisation or the blocking of data processed in violation of the law, as well as opposing its processing in any case for legitimate reasons.

The rights can be exercised upon informal request to the owner of the processing also by registered letter, fax or e-mail.
